

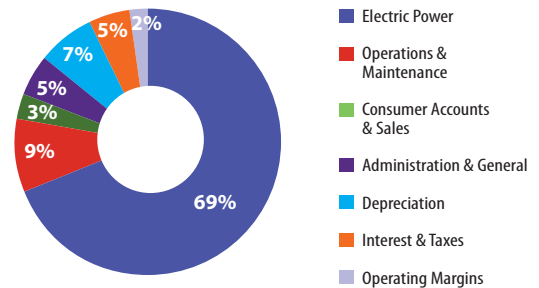

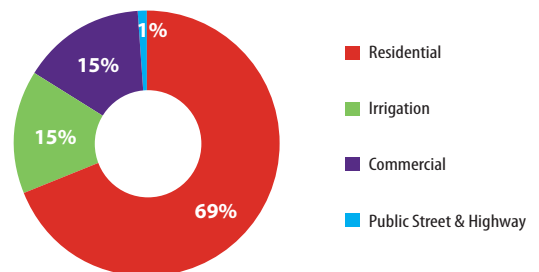

WATT'S COOKING



Eggplant and Beef Casserole

- 1 Medium Eggplant
- 1 Small Onion
- 3 tbsp. butter
- 1 Can of Cream of Mushroom soup
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 1 Egg, slightly beaten
- 1 cup grated mild cheddar cheese
- ¾ cup cracker crumbs
- ¾ lbs. of hamburger meat browned and drained
- ½ cup of spaghetti sauce



Peel, slice and chop eggplant. Cook until tender in boiling salt water. Once cooked, drain and smash eggplant. Sauté onion in butter until tender and brown your meat. Drain meat and combine with smashed eggplant. Combine eggplant, beef/onion mixture with soup, ½ cup of cheese and ½ cup of bread crumbs. Place in a well-greased 2qt casserole dish then add remaining cheese and bread crumbs. Bake at 350° for 30 minutes or until cheese is golden brown.
